Freedom of the press is freedom of communication and expression through various electronic media and published materials. This freedom means the media will function with the absence of any interference from government authorities.

Many countries have laws that protect the media, though in some cases these laws are not respected. According to Reporters Without Borders, more than a third of the world's people live in countries where there's no press freedom. Overwhelmingly, these people live in countries where there is no system of democracy with serious deficiencies in the democratic process. Freedom of the press is an extremely problematic concept for most non-democratic systems of government. There is a strict critical control of access to information and they are associated with control system and security apparatus. Most non democratic societies employ state-run news organizations to promote their propaganda. The aim is to maintain an existing political power base and overpower any significant attempts by the media or individual journalists to challenge the approved government line on contentious issues. In such countries, journalists operating on the fringes of what is deemed to be acceptable will very often find themselves the subject of considerable intimidation by agents of the state. This can range from simple threats to their professional careers.
